

Homebuilder donates \$90K in furniture and fixtures for Habitat

Habitat for Humanity of East and Central Pasco County received its largest furniture donation in 2025 from a top ReStore donor. A longstanding Habitat for Humanity supporter, GL Homes donated cabinets, countertops, curtains, kitchen sinks, lighting fixtures, appliances and office furniture totaling \$90,000 from its Winding Ridge community in Wesley Chapel.

In the last five years, GL Homes has donated \$200,000 in furniture and building supplies to Habitat's ReStore in Pasco County. The sales from donated items help Habitat for Humanity partner with local families to build, rehabilitate and repair safe and affordable homes in local communities and around the world — a good deal for the customer, the community and the environment.
